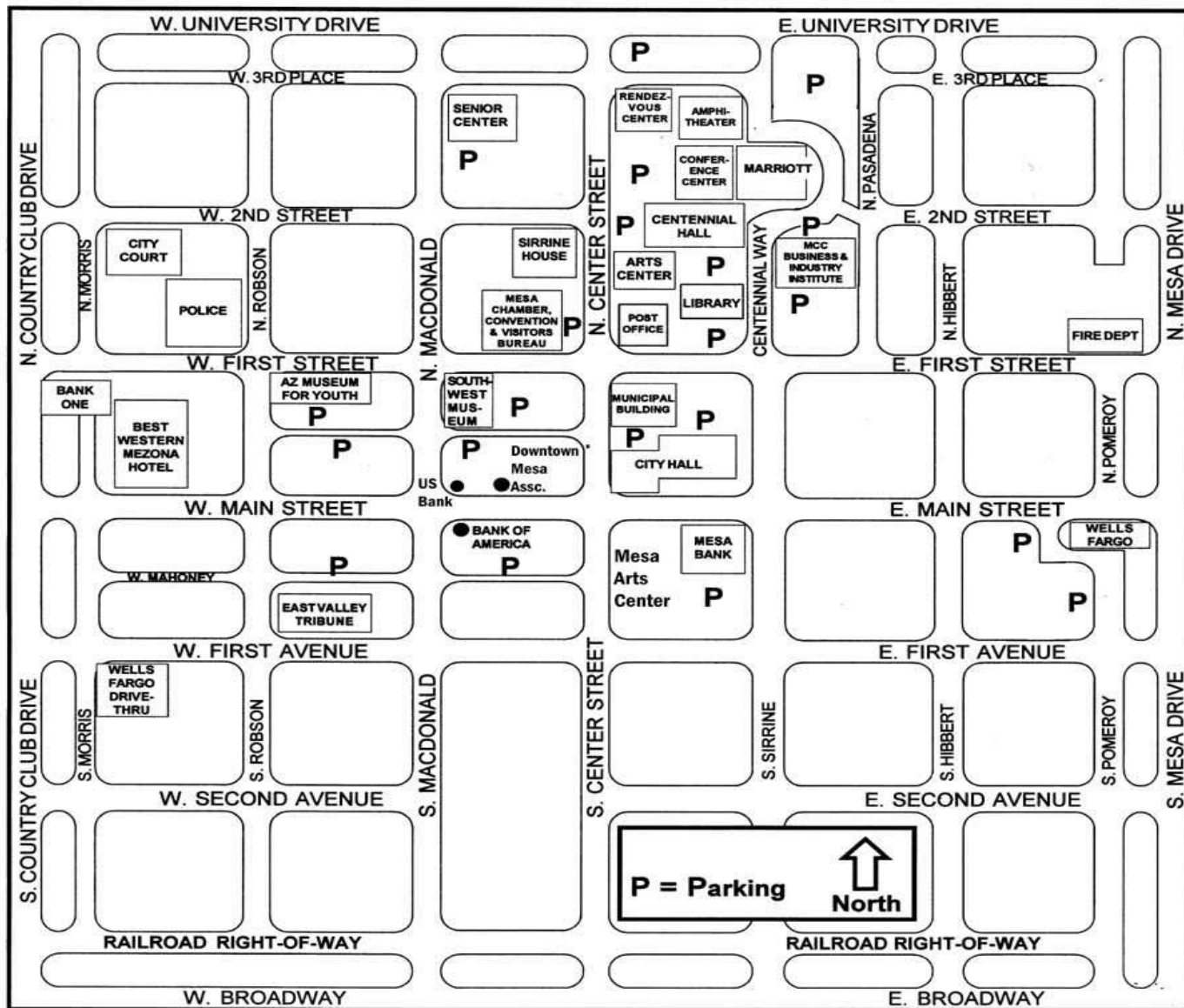
Cruises in Review:
